If a rider is inactive for three consecutive years, all their points will expire completely." - can someone correct it?</li> <li>• (Change #1 to be considered / discussed) Due to covid you can't host any competitions, had the rule is stated to include scores only in the past several years (like past 3 years) things would have been solved. FYI, the rule now "For each athlete, a COMPETITION RANKING SCORE will be calculated based on the sum of the top 4 placement scores from the last 6 local competitions. This system will ensure fairness for athletes who missed a local competition due to overseas representation or injury, it also allows talented newcomers to achieve high ranking scores quicker."</li> <li>• (Change #2 to be considered) It's important that we respect the result of each competition, i.e. someone won 1st in the comp, should be because allowed a chance / subject to agreement of all committees to get into HK Team, i.e. that person could win given LUCK / or real performance, but committee group should have the judgement call.
